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Exploring a vineyard is also about exploring the region and destination around it. It is about meeting the people whose hands shape the vines, feel the soil, harvest the grapes and press the juice. Whether they were born and bred here or simply fell in love with the slopes of the Força Real hill or the Roussillon plain, every chance to meet our local producers opens a door to the history of the terroir. There are so many different ways to discover the world of wine in Roussillon Conflent, on specialised visits with explanations about local geology or nature, by going on a hike or on a “wine safari” for example.

THE REGION'S WINEGROWING ESTATES

Our terroir is crossed by the **Pays de l'Agly wine route** and the **wine route of the lower Têt valley and Roussillon plain**, and is home to **4 PDO appellations** (Côtes du Roussillon, Côtes du Roussillon Villages, Côtes du Roussillon Villages Caramany, Rivesaltes and Muscat de Rivesaltes) and **1 PGI appellation** (Côtes Catalanes).

Of our destination's **10 winegrowing estates**, **9 are certified organic (AB in French), High Environmental Value (HVE in French) or “Nature & Progrès”**. They are all committed to respecting the terroir and promoting their profession.

Organic certified estates:

- **Domaine Forca Réal (Millas) / Make an appointment to visit**
- **Domaine Clot de l'Oum (Bélesta) / Wine cellar open to the public**
- **Domaine Carle Courty (Millas) / Wine cellar open to the public - 2022 Independent Winegrowers prize. Sustainable farming approach**

Estates with the “Nature & Progrès” certification:

- **Domaine Riberach (Bélesta) / Wine cellar open to the public - “Vignobles & Découvertes” label**

Estates with High Environmental Value certification:

- **Domaine Pélissier (Millas) / Wine cellar open to the public**

- *Domaine de Caladroy (Bélesta) / Wine cellar open to the public - “Vignobles & Découvertes” label*

Our winemaking cooperatives:

- *The winegrowers of Força Réal (Millas) / Cooperative La Catalane open to the public*

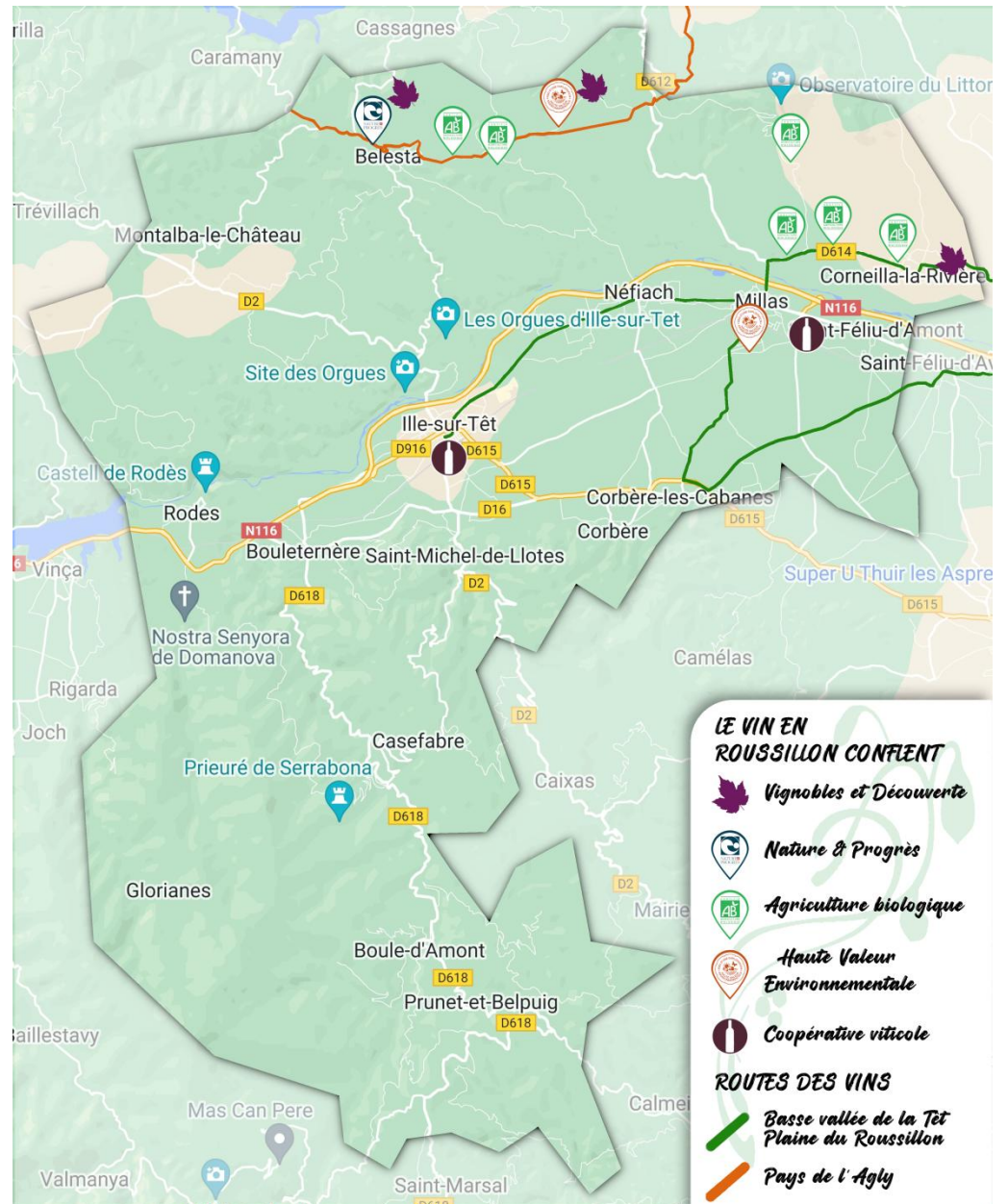
ESTATES OFFERING ECO-FRIENDLY WINE TOURISM ACTIVITIES

- The **Domaine de Caladroy** organises “Nature & Terroir wine escapade” activities with a Natur’ailes 66 nature guide.
- The **Domaine Lafforgue** organises tours of the estate on horseback, in partnership with Equitet Rando.
- The **Domaine Riberach**, part of the Riberach complex, includes the restaurant La Coopérative, with a Michelin green star, and the Riberach 4-star ecolodge, which offers wine treks on the estate.
- The **Domaine Riberach and Domaine de Caladroy** are also featured stops on the “Discovering the North Balconies of the Canigó” route, winner of the “Unexpected Territories” challenge organised by ADN Tourisme (national federation of tourist offices) as part of a Slow Tourism approach.

The Roussillon Conflent Intercommunal Tourist Office, located on the wine route of the lower Têt valley in Ille sur Têt, is also a **member of the Tourisme de Terroir@-Pyrénées Orientales network**.
